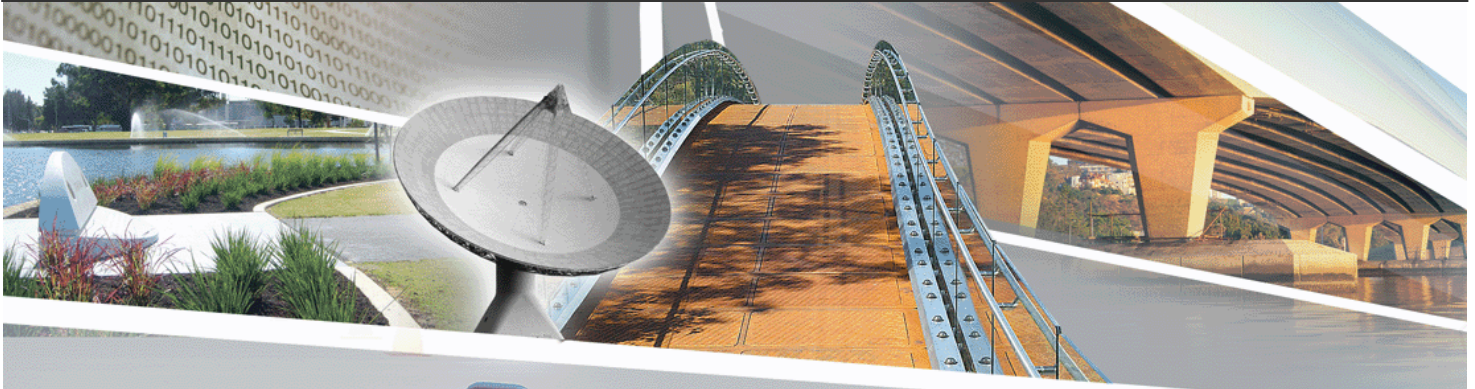


Back to School?

Ken Lee currently works for Western Power as an Access Accounts Manager, and is part of a team that is responsible for annual revenue in excess of \$600M. His responsibilities include developing and maintaining customer relations, as well as the management of customer contracts and Service Level Agreements.

Ken graduated in 1994 from UWA with a double degree of B.Eng (Electrical, 1st class) B.Com (Management). Ken completed his MBA from the Graduate School of Management in 2004 while working full time with Western Power.

Most recently, Ken was part of a project team that identified over \$13M of improvements within Western Power's \$500M operating and capital expenditure programs.

Patrik completed his B.Eng (Production Engineering) in June 2002. Patrik started in industry supervising the production and assembling activities as well as machine maintenance at a castor manufacturer.
